



**Colorado Mountain Express *Fill the Van* Food Drive
stocks shelves for the Family & Intercultural Resource Center**

Summit County residents invited to donate Sat. Nov 12 at area City Market stores and Walmart

EDWARDS, Colo., Nov. 10, 2011 – Colorado Mountain Express (CME) 15th annual *Fill the Van* food drive is underway this Saturday, November 12 across Summit County. From 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. CME vans will be parked in front of City Market stores in Dillon and Breckenridge, Safeway in Silverthorne and Walmart in Frisco with staff accepting non-perishable food benefiting the Family & Intercultural Resource Center (FIRC) in Dillon.

"Fill the Van is the largest and most important food drive of the year for Summit County, raising around 10,000 pounds of food for local food banks," said Rob Murphy, the community support manager at FIRC. "CME's efforts ensure that local families struggling to afford enough food have adequate resources during the coldest parts of the winter season."

Already food is being collected for the Family & Intercultural Resource Center thanks to the efforts of Summit County schools. CME vans will be picking up donations from the schools on Friday, November 11.

"In 2010, 15 tons of food was collected benefiting food pantries statewide thanks to the generosity of residents across our Colorado mountain resort communities and Vail Resorts employees," says Robert Tschupp, vice president and general manager of Colorado Mountain Express. "We welcome donations from the community this Saturday."

In addition to Summit County, CME is collecting food this Saturday in Eagle County benefiting the Vail Valley Salvation Army and in the Roaring Fork Valley benefiting LIFT-UP. Also, Vail Resorts employees in Broomfield are collecting food benefiting Denver's Food Bank of the Rockies. The 2010 *Fill the Van* food drive generated over 30,000 lbs (15 tons) of donated food filling shelves of pantries statewide.

CME's *Fill the Van* is one of the largest food drives in Colorado. It is an annual effort by Vail Resorts Echo, the company's corporate sustainability program.
